ADMISSION POLICY

The school admits children regardless of their colour, race, religion or sex. For admission in **grade 8** the child must have completed and progressed in grade 7.

The following documents are required when applying for admission: -

- Transfer letter, which is not more than three months old
- Academic Report card or profile of the current or previous grade
- Original birth certificate or certified copy therefore
- Certified copy of ID of parent / guardian

SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The school exercises firm but kind discipline. The following acts are strongly prohibited by the school and may lead to serious action.

Learners are expected to put on school uniform during all school activities and attend promptly and regularly. Any other rules set by the school from time to time are as binding as the ones listed above.

SCHOOL FEES

1. Tuition fees for the whole year is R 53 640.00 with payment option of R4 470.00 monthly installments with the following provisions: -

- ✓ Quarterly, half yearly, and annual payments with a discount of 2.5%, 5%, and 7% respectively.
- ✓ Additional child discount. A discount of 10% to the fees of the additional child.

2. Boarding fees (excluding tuition) for the whole year is R61 600.00 with payment option of R5 600.00 monthly instalments plus Tuition fees.
